

Thank you for your interest in CSA! Please take a few minutes to review our farm's CSA Agreement.

What is CSA?

CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. Prior to the growing season, CSA members purchase 'shares' or 'baskets' of the crops the farm will produce. These will then be picked up weekly at the farm by the members.

When it comes to prioritizing what produce goes where, the CSA program gets priority over the market and other direct sales, both in quality and quantity. Becoming a CSA member is the ultimate way to support our farm, and in return we make it our endeavor to supply them with the finest produce that can be found locally!

Basket Examples

Our farm grows a wide range of vegetables that vary throughout the growing season. Our goal is to provide several different crops each week. Below are real examples of baskets we put together when we were operating a CSA on our previous farm.

Shared Risk

Farmers and CSA members share the risk associated with farming. It is very important to understand this before purchasing. If crops are unavailable due to natural circumstances like drought, crop failure, pests, etc., it may affect the quantity and/or quality of the produce in your basket. There are no refunds!

Pick Up

The farm is just a 5-minute drive from Moscow! (3123 W. Twin Rd, Moscow, ID). The farm will be open for CSA pick up on **Thursday evenings (4-6pm) and Friday mornings (9-11am)**. If these dates or times don't work for you, please contact us directly and we most likely can work something out. It is also important that CSA members notify us if they will be unavailable for pickup on a certain week.

Pricing & Dates

We aim to provide *an average* of \$30 of produce, per week over the course of our 15-week summer growing season. For example, the early weeks of the CSA program, you will likely receive produce valued slightly under \$30. However, during the height of the growing season, your basket will be filled with more than \$30 worth of produce. We will track the baskets, their value over the growing season, and the weekly average. The CSA will run for 15 weeks, starting June 5, 2025 and ending September 11, 2025.

The share price of \$450 (plus tax, equals \$477) is due in full by May 18, 2025.

Sign Up & Open House

Finally, there are several ways to pay. You can mail a check with your sign-up form, we take Venmo (ask for the link), or you can pay with cash or card on **May 18**th, during an open house here on the farm. Please let us know on your sign-up form how you will be paying. We highly encourage everyone to come to the open house, but it is not 'mandatory'.
